

# **Venues and Location**


The Overshoot Conference 2025 will be held in Laxenburg, Austria, in the following venue:

### How to reach the venue?

#### BY AIR

Airport arrival and departure: Vienna Airport.

You can obtain more information on airlines travelling to Vienna Airport by clicking here.

Please note all attendees are responsible for arranging their own travel.

On arrival at Vienna Airport, you can use the following transport options to reach Vienna from the airport:

- **CAT Train** (express to Landstrasse): you can find information and timetables by clicking <a href="here">here</a>. Please note a one-way ticket is priced at €14.90.
- ÖBB local train: The nearest station to Motel One Hauptbahnhof is the Vienna Central Train Station (Hauptbahnhof). There are direct trains that leave from Vienna airport station (Flughafen Wien Bahnhof) to the Vienna Central Train Station (Hauptbahnhof) every half an hour. A one-way ticket is priced at €4.60. Children below 6 years travel for free, and from 6 to 15 years pay half price. You can find further information and timetables by clicking here.
- Vienna Airport Bus: a one-way ticket is priced at €11.00. You can find further information and timetables by clicking here.
- Taxi: Taxis are also available in abundance outside the terminal building and cost is circa €40. BY TRAIN

#### **BY TRAIN**

Vienna has good rail connections to all major European cities. On arrival by train, you can travel throughout the city using the local U-Bahn (metro) or underground trains if needed. The nearest station to the Motel One Hauptbahnhof hotel is the Vienna Central Train Station (Wien Hauptbahnhof) (see below to find info on how to reach the Hotel from there). You can find all information related to local Vienna transportation including a U-Bahn map by clicking <a href="hete">here</a>.

#### Recommended apps:

Tickets can be bought at every train or metro station from cashiers, machines, on the website or through apps. We recommend downloading the <u>ÖBB Scotty</u> and <u>ÖBB Tickets app</u> for route planning and ticket purchasing. Information on the validity of tickets and types of tickets is available within the apps (also in English). Ticket machines are available at every station and accept both cash and card payments.

PLEASE NOTE: When traveling to Laxenburg (via bus 200 or 210), you can also buy tickets on the bus; however, only cash payments are accepted.

Single ticket (standard price) for the city of Vienna (core zone) cost €2.40, between the Airport and Vienna Central Station is €4.50 (with ÖBB trains). The price of a single ticket between Vienna (core zone) and Laxenburg is €5.20 valid for two hours (to start the journey) and changing lines is allowed. Daily ticket is €13.50.

#### Shuttle Service (for free)

The organizers will provide shuttle bus transportation between Vienna (pick up location: Motel One, Gerhard-Bronner-Straße 11) and IIASA Laxenburg. The bus will stop in front of the main entrance of the hotel.

The pick-up and departure times will be indicated in our program on our website.

Please, make sure you check the IIASA/Overshoot conference sign in front of the bus before entering.

The distance from Vienna to Laxenburg is 26 kilometers and the transfer time takes around 30-35 minutes.

#### Regular Bus


Alternatively, there are regular buses (Bus 200 and 210, Terminal N2) to Laxenburg leaving from the Vienna Central Train Station's bus terminal approximately every 20-30 minutes. The nearest bus stop to the Conference Venue is Laxenburg Franz-Joseph-Platz. You can look up times to the designated route by clicking here.

### Accommodation

The Motel One Hauptbahnhof is conveniently located at Vienna's Central Train Station (Wien Hauptbahnhof). Please note all attendees are responsible for arranging their own accommodation.

### How to reach the airport from the hotel

Taxis are readily available both in the city center and at Wien Hauptbahnhof, including during the night. If you would like to book a taxi for a specific date and time, the hotel reception will be happy to arrange one for you.

Alternatively, buses run from **Wien Hauptbahnhof Süd (Am Hauptbahnhof Platz)** to the airport every hour throughout the day. ### Weather in September/October

Average temperature: around 15 °C

Maximum daytime temperature: up to 18–20 °C Minimum nighttime temperature: around 10–12 °C

Austria operates on 220-240 Volts. Electrical sockets (outlets) types: German style plug (Type F) and Europlug (Type C) with 2 round pins. It is recommended that participants bring their own electrical/travel plug adaptor.
