Overshoot Conference – 24–25 November 2026, Beijing, China

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Venues and Location

The Overshoot Conference 2026 will be held in Beijing, China, at the following venue:

The Xijiao Hotel is located within walking distance of Tsinghua University and serves as both the conference venue and the official accommodation. It offers around 500 guest rooms, over 20 small and medium meeting rooms, and two large rooms (capacities of 150+ and 500+). Catering during the conference will be buffet-style to accommodate diverse dietary requirements.

How to Reach the Venue

By Air

Airport arrival and departure: Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK) is the airport most commonly used to reach the Tsinghua University area. Beijing Daxing International Airport (PKX) is a second option but is considerably further from the venue.

Please note all attendees are responsible for arranging their own travel, unless otherwise confirmed by the Organising team.

On arrival at Beijing Capital Airport, options to reach the Xijiao Hotel / Tsinghua University area include:

- **Taxi:** only use official taxis from the designated airport taxi stand. The fare to the Tsinghua University area is typically around 150 RMB, including a 10 RMB highway toll.
- **Airport Express + Subway:** take the Airport Express (one-way ticket approx. 25 RMB) to Sanyuanqiao, then Subway Line 10 to Zhichunlu, transfer to Line 13 towards Wudaokou, and continue by bus or taxi to the venue.



- **Airport Bus:** the Zhongguancun route stops at Tsinghua Science Park (one-way ticket approx. 30 RMB), followed by a short taxi ride (approx. 15 RMB) to the venue.

General Information

Weather in November

Beijing in late November is cold and dry. Average daytime maximum temperatures are around 10°C (50°F), with nighttime lows around or below freezing, especially in the second half of the month. Winds from the north/northwest can make it feel colder. Rain is minimal (a few days of light precipitation), though an early snowfall is possible. Participants are advised to bring warm layers, a coat, and a scarf/gloves.

Electricity

China operates on 220 V at 50 Hz. Sockets in China are types A, C and I (China's own three-pin standard). European (Type C/F) and US (Type A/B) plugs will need an adapter; US participants bringing 120 V-only devices will also need a voltage converter. Participants are recommended to bring their own travel adaptor.

Local Currency

The official currency in China is the Renminbi / Chinese Yuan (RMB, ¥ / CNY). Mobile payment apps (Alipay, WeChat Pay) are used for most transactions in China, including by many taxis and small vendors; foreign credit cards are not always accepted, and USD/EUR cash is not usable directly. Participants are advised to set up a mobile payment app linked to an international card where possible, and/or withdraw RMB from an ATM on arrival.

- West side of the Tsinghua campus. Handles common illnesses; 24/7 emergency coverage, refers serious cases off-campus. Bring a passport.
